Move In Information

For move-in day on Thursday, August 22, new students should schedule their arrival between 7:30 and 10:30 a.m. Upon entering campus grounds, there will be signs that will guide you towards your assigned Residence Hall (whether it be Mary, Tommy, Bernard, Boniface, Patrick, etc). Arriving with knowledge of which floor and hall you are designated for streamlines coordination in locating appropriate unloading spots organized by our hardworking orientation leaders, resident assistants and other student staff volunteers. If you feel lost, ask a volunteer!

Upon arriving at your designated unloading zone, students will be directed to Sexton Commons for check-in. As you proceed with the process, family members are kindly requested to unload your vehicle and safely park elsewhere, allowing others space to do so too. To facilitate moving in smoothly, orientation leaders, alongside other staff volunteers, shall assist by moving your belongings up into your rooms. Once this is complete, both student and accompanying relatives may reconvene within the room as they finalize settling down in readiness for campus activities ahead.

Upon arrival, new students and their families will receive a warm greeting from the Residential Life staff at Sexton Commons and in their respective communities. 


