

Exception to Music Scholarship Policy

Exception to Scholarship - Instrument Change Policy

Any potential situation regarding changing scholarship instrument should be brought to the department and dealt with on a case by case basis with the best interest of the student in mind. If it is determined that the student may audition for scholarship on a different instrument, that audition may only take place during the spring of each academic year. If a new scholarship is awarded, it will be no greater than the original scholarship and will be implemented in the fall of the following academic year. Only in cases where the award in the new applied area is lower than the amount granted initially on a different instrument will there be a temporary loss of a portion of financial aid. Students who choose to change their instrument must complete the required number of semesters of lessons on the new instrument as per the award amount.

Exception to Scholarship – Fine Arts Scholarship Change Policy

Switching a fine arts scholarship (Art or Theater) to music will also follow the policy above. All departments involved must be notified by the student in order to initiate review of the matter.
