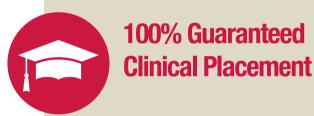

Develop specific competencies

The main focus of this program is on the five competencies for the executive nurse leader certification:

- Professionalism

DNP: Leadership (BSN-to-DNP) ELIGIBILITY

- A 4-year nursing degree from an accredited program conferred prior to the start of the program
- Cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
- Current, unencumbered licensure as a registered nurse
- Preferred qualifications for admission include a minimum 1-year of leadership experience (health care or other)
