- THE 2-YEAR MN TRANSFER CURRICULUM (MNTC).



Way of Thinking - Social World	Completed via History/Social Science course(s)
Thematic Encounter Course (100- or 200-level)	Successful completion of MNTC or AA Degree

Students **must** earn a grade of "C" or higher for course credits to transfer to CSB/SJU. If a lower, passing grade was earned for a course, the requirement will be satisfied, but no course credits will be awarded.
